Dr. James White

James White is the director of Alpha and Omega Ministries. He is Professor of Church History and Apologetics at Grace Bible Theological Seminary, and has taught Greek, Hebrew, Systematic Theology, Textual Criticism, Church History and various topics in the field of apologetics for numerous other schools. He has authored or contributed to more than twenty four books, including *The King James Only Controversy, The Forgotten Trinity, The Potter's Freedom, The God Who Justifies* and *What Every Christian Needs to Know About the Qur'an*. He is an accomplished debater, having engaged in more than one hundred eighty moderated, public debates with leading proponents of Roman Catholicism, Islam, Jehovah's Witnesses, and Mormonism, as well as critics such as Bart Ehrman, John Dominic Crossan, Marcus Borg, and John Shelby Spong. Before travel restrictions James debated in such locations as London, Sydney, as well as in mosques in Toronto and South Africa. He is a Pastor/Elder of Apologia Church in Arizona. He has been married to Kelli for more than forty years, and has two children, and five living grandchildren.

Dr. Paul Michael Raymond

Rev. Dr. Paul Michael Raymond is the pastor of the Reformed Bible Church in Central Virginia @ Appomattox which is committed to the Reformed tradition of "Sola Scriptura", with a strong emphasis upon the Christian's Cultural Mandate of Genesis 1:28. Originally established in 1992 in Suffolk County New York, Rev. Raymond along with others of the RBC session, expanded the ministry in 1998 by planting a church in Virginia, and by 2001 established The Institute for Theonomic Reformation. In 2009 the work continued to expand with the establishment of The New Geneva Christian Leadership Academy; an undergraduate, graduate and seminary level scholarship training entity. He has also been a court appointed advocate working with the juvenile justice system and the local department of social services. Dr. Raymond is a graduate of Whitefield Theological Seminary, holds a Masters degree from Whitefield, and a doctorate from Almeda Theological University. The Reformed Bible church is affiliated with The Alliance of Reformed and Theonomic Churches (ARTC) of which Dr. Raymond is a founding member. He has been married to his wife, Jane, for 38 years and together they have 3 children and 2 grandchildren.

A graduate of Washington Bible College with a degree in Biblical Studies, Joel was a youth pastor at Twin Valley Bible Chapel in Narvon, PA, before his secular career. After 20 years of career, study, and teaching ministry, he readily agreed to join and help launch the MARS organization. Joel is the Executive Director of MARS and teaches regularly at the MARS lecture series on a variety of social and political topics. He is also the pastor of Independence Reformed Bible Church of Morgantown, PA. Joel resides with his wife, Audrey, in Denver, PA and has 9 grown children and 27 grandchildren.



Joel Saint

Matt has been the pastor of Mercy Seat Christian Church for 35 years – a congregation located in the Milwaukee, Wisconsin area. He and his wife, Clara, have been married 41 years. They have 11 children, and 30 grandchildren. He is the founder of Missionaries to the Preborn which was instrumental in seeing abortion in Wisconsin drop by over 60% from 1990 to 2022, Pastor Matt spent over 15 months in jail for interposing on behalf of the preborn at the doors of the deathcamps. He is the author of the book *The Doctrine of the Lesser Magistrates: A Proper Response to Tyranny and A Repudiation of Unlimited Obedience to Civil Government* which has sold over 100,000 copies. He has spoken to countless magistrates, conducted countless news, radio, and podcast interviews, and has been invited to speak before legislators in 11 states. He preached his first sermon exposing the false narrative of the covid pretend-demic on March 22, 2020 – just nine days after Trump announced the national emergency. The sermon was entitled A Contrarian Look at Covid 19. He went on to expose the evil, preaching a series of sermons regarding the matter over the next two years – the sermons had hundreds of thousands of listens. Christopher Arnzen

Chris Arnzen is a veteran of radio, having decades of experience employed in that field since the mid-1980s. He was the Long Island Account Executive for WMCA-570AM & WWDJ-970AM in New York, affiliates of Salem Media (the largest Christian radio network in the world) for 15 years (1991-2005). While employed there, Chris created a nightly program titled "The Voice of Sovereign Grace", which was hosted by 5 different theologically Reformed ministry leaders every week (including R. J. Rushdoony), and remained on the air for nearly a decade. Chris also caught "the talk radio host bug" himself while employed by Salem when WMCA's inhouse talk show host, Andy Andersen, began to request that Chris fill in for him during Andy's time off for vacation or illness. After Andy's home-going to Christ subsequent to his bout with cancer, Chris was the fill-in host for 2 full weeks prior to when Andy's permanent replacement was found. In 2005 Chris launched his own daily talk radio show, "Iron Sharpens Iron", originally out of WNYG-1440AM & WGBB-1240AM in Babylon, Long island, NY. After relocating to Carlisle, PA, in 2015, Chris relaunched "Iron Sharpens Iron" where it continues to be heard globally at www.lronSharpensIronRadio.com via live-streaming. Over the years, Chris has interviewed and has received glowing written commendations from many of the most highly respected and globally renowned Christian thinkers, including the late R. C. Sproul, John MacArthur, Steven Lawson, Joel Beeke, Doug Wilson, Geoff Thomas, Maurice Roberts, Paul Washer, Ken Ham, George Grant and Dr. James R. White.
